Things to note:

- Skate sharpening is not available on site. Closest option is Source for Sports in Bracebridge or 4 Sports in Parry Sound.
- Scotiabank is on Highway 118, just past the locks. Port Carling Foodland is also just off Highway 118. Has bank machine.
- Closest gas station is the Esso, also on Highway 118. Has bank machine.
- The Port Carling Legion is directly across the road from the arena. They will be serving their regular Sunday Breakfast Buffet from 9-noon for \$10 for adults/\$5 for children under 12 including homemade muffins!
